ABSTRACT AND PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDE

PAPER SUBMISSION PROCESS

The paper submission and review process is as follows:

1. Submission of an Abstract, author to indicate their preferred type of submission (Paper, Poster or Lightning). Posters and Lightning Presentations will be given 3 minute talk time. Presentation timing will be strictly enforced.
2. Abstract reviewed, accepted or declined by reviewer.
3. Authors of accepted Abstracts invited to submit a Draft Paper or Poster.
4. Paper reviewed, feedback given, corrections and changes requested.
5. Submission of Final Paper.

SUBMITTING AN ABSTRACT

Abstracts must be submitted online.

Requirements for submitting an Abstract:

- Abstracts must be no longer than 350 words
- The presenting authors name must be identified online
- Abstracts must be text only. Graphics, pictures or graphs should not be submitted

REVIEW CRITERIA

The Reviewers will look at the following points when deciding to accept or decline submitted Abstract/s.

- Relevance to conference theme
- Technical content
- Originality
- Organisation, grammar and style

PRESENTATION FORMATS

Abstracts may be submitted for the following presentation types:

- **Full paper presentation** - 10 minute oral presentation (plus question and answer time at the end of the session)
- **Poster session** - poster displayed throughout the conference on poster boards and a dedicated poster forum that includes 3 minute oral presentation for each poster.
- **Lightning Presentation** – up to 5 slide presentation and a strictly enforced 3 minute talk time on a subject relevant to the conference theme

THEMES

Papers, posters or lightning presentations are invited on the following topics:

DAMS FOR RESILIENT COMMUNITIES THEMES

1. THE ROLE OF DAMS AND LEVEES IN CREATING RESILIENT COMMUNITIES

Water supply, flood management, drought management, power generation (hydro and other renewables), irrigation for improved food supply and security, waste treatment.

2. OPERATION OF DAMS AND LEVEES TO PROTECT COMMUNITIES

Improved flood management, improved drought management, safety.

3. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TO ENSURE RESILIENT COMMUNITIES

Consequence assessments, itinerant assessments, dam break assessments, emergency plans, evacuation planning, warning systems.

4. ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL BENEFITS AND IMPACTS

Awareness, communication with downstream communities, community benefits and advantages, insurance, early warning systems, environmental and social benefits.

Design approaches for resilience, addressing climate change impacts, new technologies, failure modes, design of safety monitoring and management systems, safety in design.

2. DESIGN AND SAFETY ISSUES FOR LEVEES RESILIENCE

Design approaches for resilience, addressing climate change impacts, new technologies, failure modes, design of safety monitoring and management systems, safety in design.

3. OPERATION FOR RESILIENCE

Asset management and maintenance, cascade operations, consenting, inspections and reviews, redundancy and reliability of Dam Safety Critical Systems, testing of gates and valves, electrical supply, and control systems.

4. CONSTRUCTION FOR RESILIENCE

Lessons learnt and past construction issues, new technologies, BIM, dam safety during construction.

GUIDELINES

While there is no limit on the number of abstracts you can submit as lead and/or presenting author, you may only present one paper, poster or lightning presentation at the conference. If you have more than one abstract accepted as presenting author you must nominate a co-author to present.

All presenting authors must register and pay to attend the full Conference. If this is not possible, you must at least register and pay to attend the full day your presentation is scheduled.

Submission of abstracts implies the author's agreement to publish the abstract in all Conference publications including the website. Successful abstracts must be presented by the author/s or a nominated co-author. All submissions should be original and not subject to copyright.

Acceptance of abstracts does not imply any payment from the Conference Committee. Authors must arrange and pay their own registration, accommodation, travel etc. to attend the Conference.

Acceptance is at the discretion of the Conference Program Committee whose decision is final.

It is important to remember that submitted Draft and Final Papers must be

- Maximum of 10 pages
- Submitted in Word document format only
- Original and not subject to copyright.
